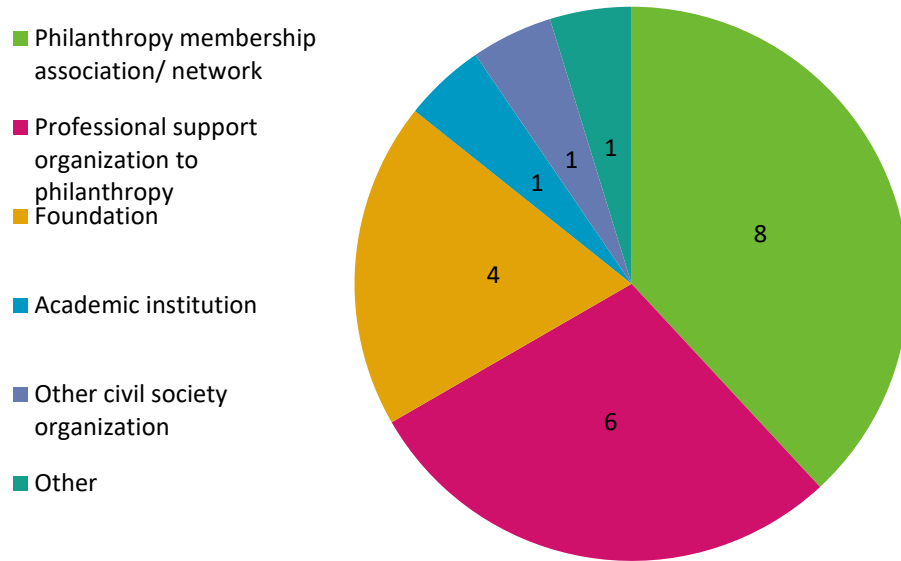

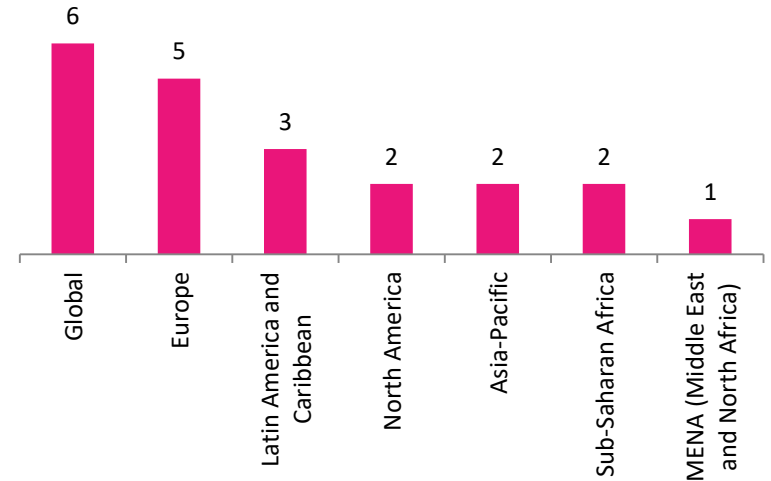

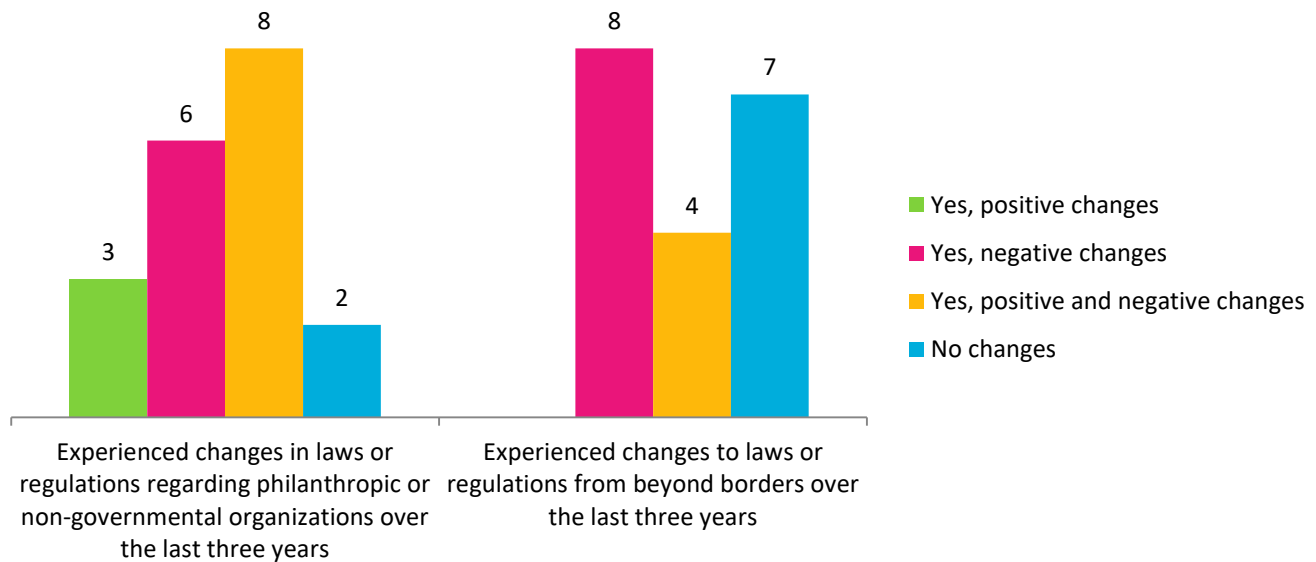
Where most of your work is conducted

Changes in laws or regulation inside and beyond borders

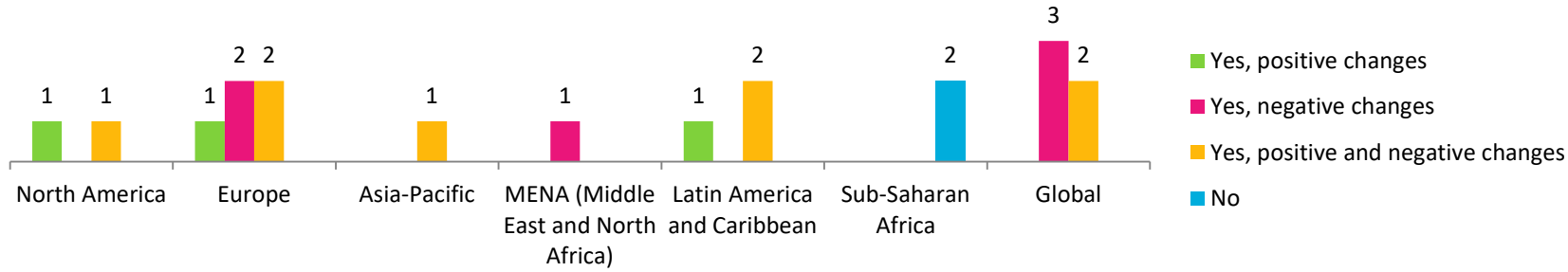

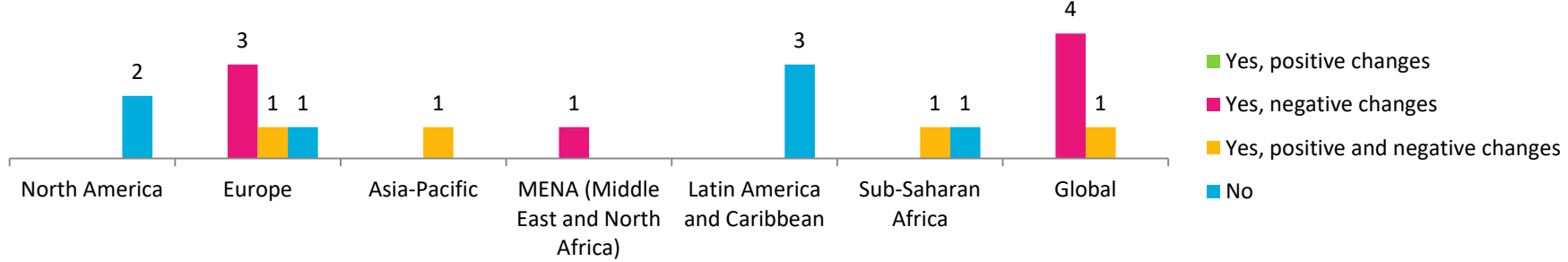

Changes in laws or regulation beyond borders per region

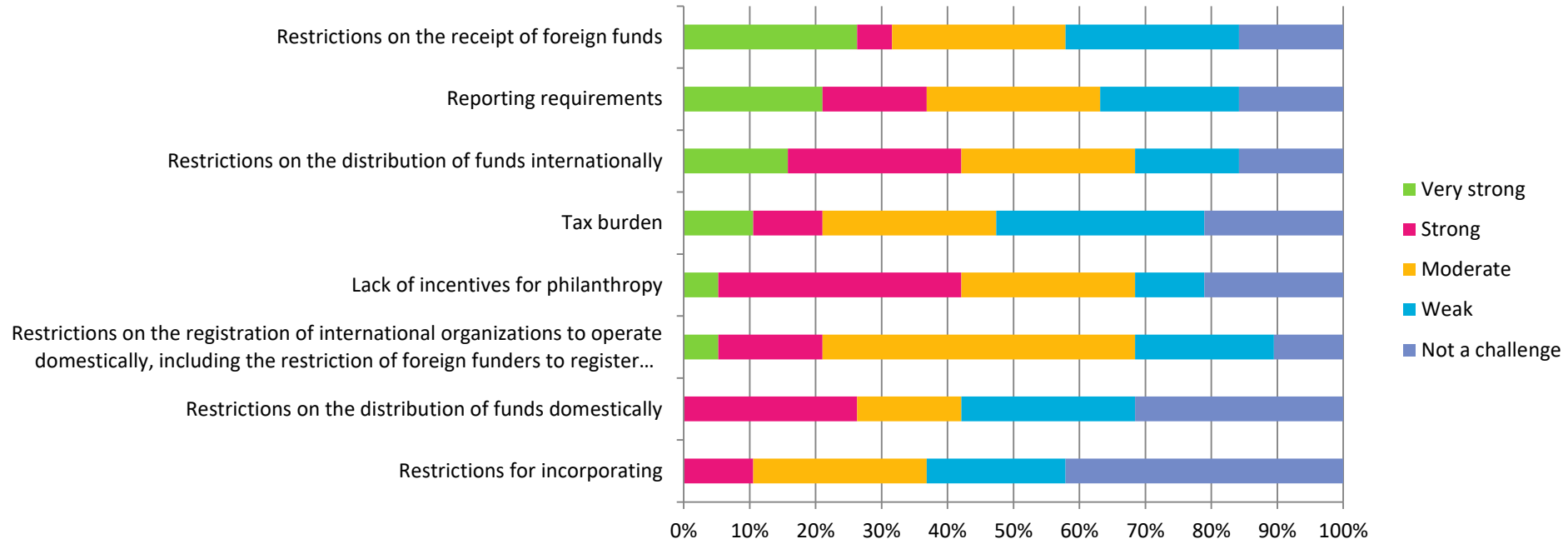

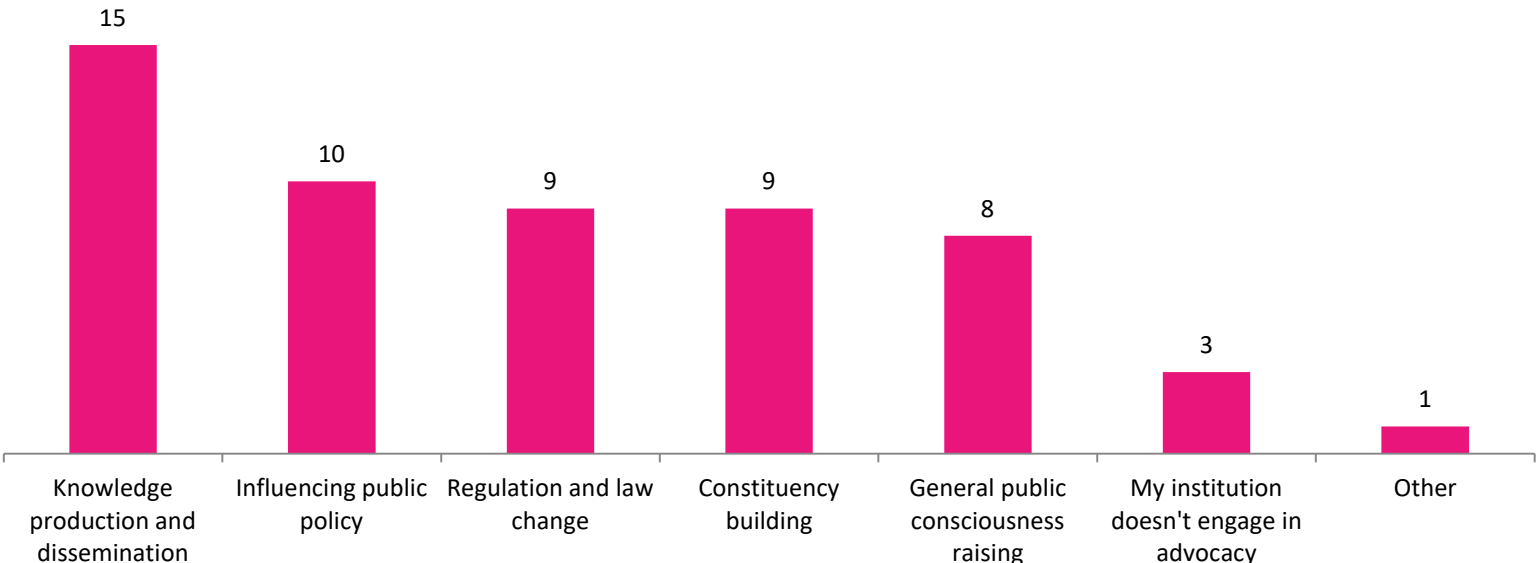

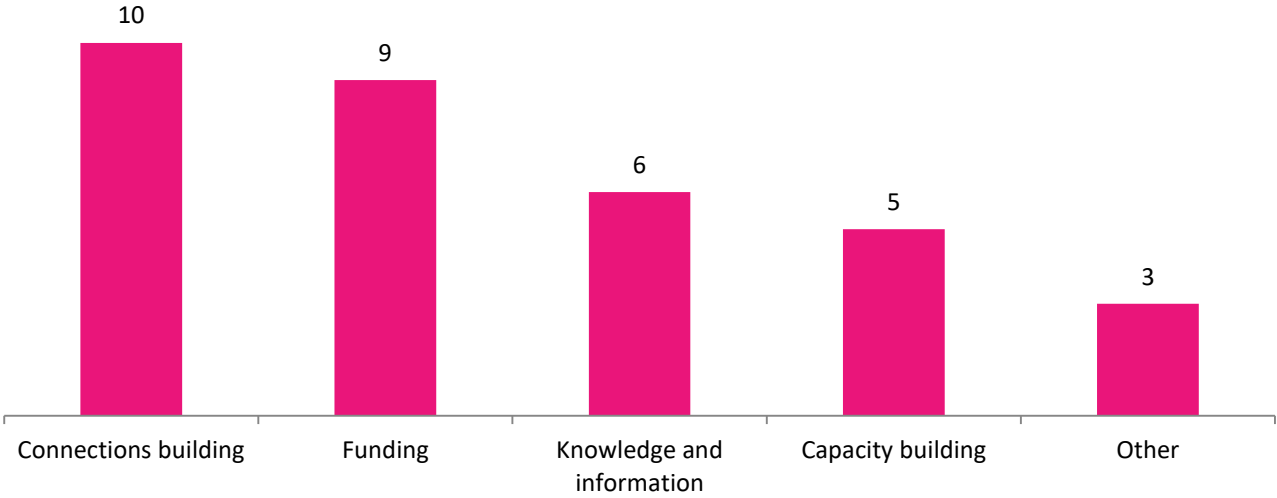
